As an instructor and mentor, Megan is highly organized, clear, student-oriented. She establishes high expectations but provides students everything they need to meet those expectations, an attitude I try to imitate as I develop my own identity as an instructor. Even though she was unbelievably busy that year, she provided us with everything we needed for a successful first year of teaching in a new place: thorough materials, consistent communication, and warm, generous support. In particular, having such thorough, detailed rubrics was an absolute life-saver for establishing clear expectations for the students and making grading as painless as possible. Perhaps the clearest testament to the trust and respect I have for her as an instructor (and person) is that she is still the first person I reach out to when I'm teaching a new course.
